




Winter Water Rules - FOR OUTSIDE CAGING -


Do not dump water from bird baths, or water bowls on the ground of cages. The water will freeze and create an icy hazard for volunteers and animals. Also, electrical cords will be frozen to the ground and unable to be moved.

Instead, please take a bucket out to the cage, pour the animal's water in the bucket and later, empty the bucket inside the clinic.

COMING OUT!




