

In 1993, a vision began in response to a need for wildlife rehabilitation and education in Waukesha County. In 1994, 837 wild patients were admitted. In 2018, WINC admitted 3,351 animals – a 25 year record!

In 1999, WINC delivered 28 education programs reaching 1,660 people. In 2018, WINC delivered 164 education programs reaching 113,038 people.

Our educational team and 13 animal ambassadors continue to meet the demand for wildlife education.
