



Dear Baby Bird Feeder Volunteer:

Thank you for your interest in the Baby Bird Feeder (BBF) program at the Wildlife in Need Center. If you would like to volunteer in 2023, please email lfosco@helpingwildlife.org to set up a brief pre-training phone interview. Please include your name, the number of attendees and a phone number. Communication for scheduling of the phone interview will be through email. After successful completion of the interview, you will be scheduled for a training.

We have 3 training classes scheduled. All volunteers, including past experienced BBF's, must attend 1 of the 3 classes. Volunteers in this program must be 12 years of age or older. Volunteers ages 12-14 must be accompanied by an adult. Parents and guardians of volunteers 15 years and older are welcome as well but not required to attend.

Please fill out an **Adult and Minor Baby Bird Feeding Application/Release Form** (which includes an Emergency Contact and Shift Availability Form), even if you have filled one out in previous years. We do ask for updated information each year. ****Please bring completed forms to your training class.**
